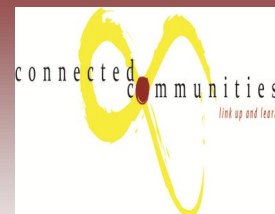

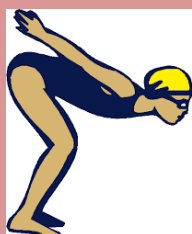

EXECUTIVE PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Yaama and welcome to the 2016 school year.

School for Year 1 to 6 students started yesterday, Thursday, and it was great to reconnect with the students after such a lengthy break and yarn about their holidays. The students are looking very proud and smart, wearing full school uniform in addition to being extremely excited to finally have full access to the new classrooms which are decked out with new technology and furniture.

Our new Kindergarten children, for 2016, will commence their first day of big school on Monday. I genuinely thank the many parents who have been working with Moree East PS since Term 4 last year that will assist with a smooth transition of their child into Kinder. However, if you know of parents who have a child who is eligible for Kindergarten (turns 5 years of age before the end of July) and have not enrolled them for school as yet, please encourage them to contact the school.

Being a new year, it is critical that you make contact with the school, in particular their new teacher and update your child's personal information. That is, if there has been a change of address, you have a new telephone number or if there is any new medical conditions. Teachers however would just appreciate the opportunity to be able to connect with you.

Please note that the school hours still remains, 8am to 1.15pm for this Term. Reynolds and Fogarty bus service continues to run before and after school. The school bus will commence a sweep of the south east housing estate on Monday. However, permission will need to be gained from you, the parent/carer for your child(ren) to be transported on the school bus. I have attached the permission note for you to complete and return.

On Monday students can commence placing lunch orders and snacks from the canteen. The canteen menu and price list, which includes items that can be ordered from the Secondary College and items that can be purchased at our school, Moree East PS canteen is attached. As MEPS will be accessing the Moree Secondary College canteen, orders must be placed by 8.15am at the latest. This is so the Secondary College canteen staff can prepare our students orders in time for the 10.30 break. Please note that, no phone orders will be accepted and money must accompany the lunch order.

Finally, the school uniform shop will now have opening days and times. Operating hours will be Wednesday's and Thursday's at 11 – 11.30am.

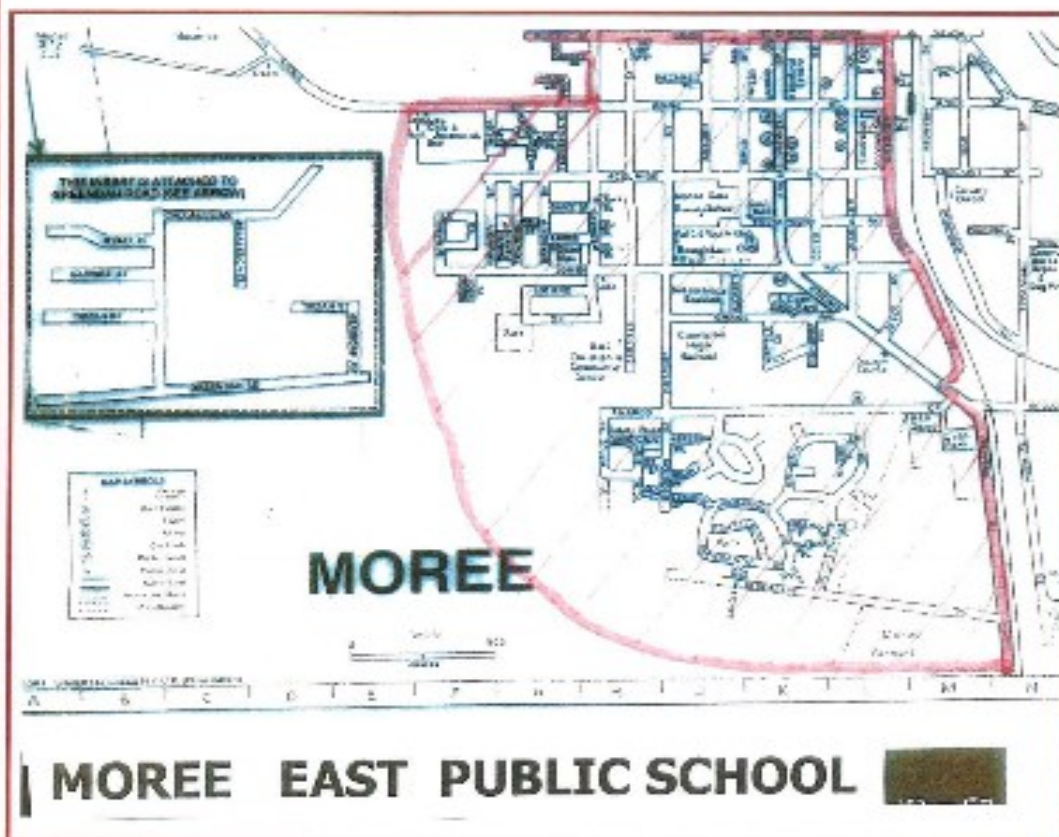
ZONING INFORMATION

entering the public system in Moree

The Public Education zones are enforced within Moree. This means for Moree East Public School, if you live on the south side of Mehi River (excluding Mehi Crescent, the housing estate just on the east side of the railway track (ie. around Maude Street and Sullivan's Place and Stanley Village) you are zoned to attend Moree East Public School.

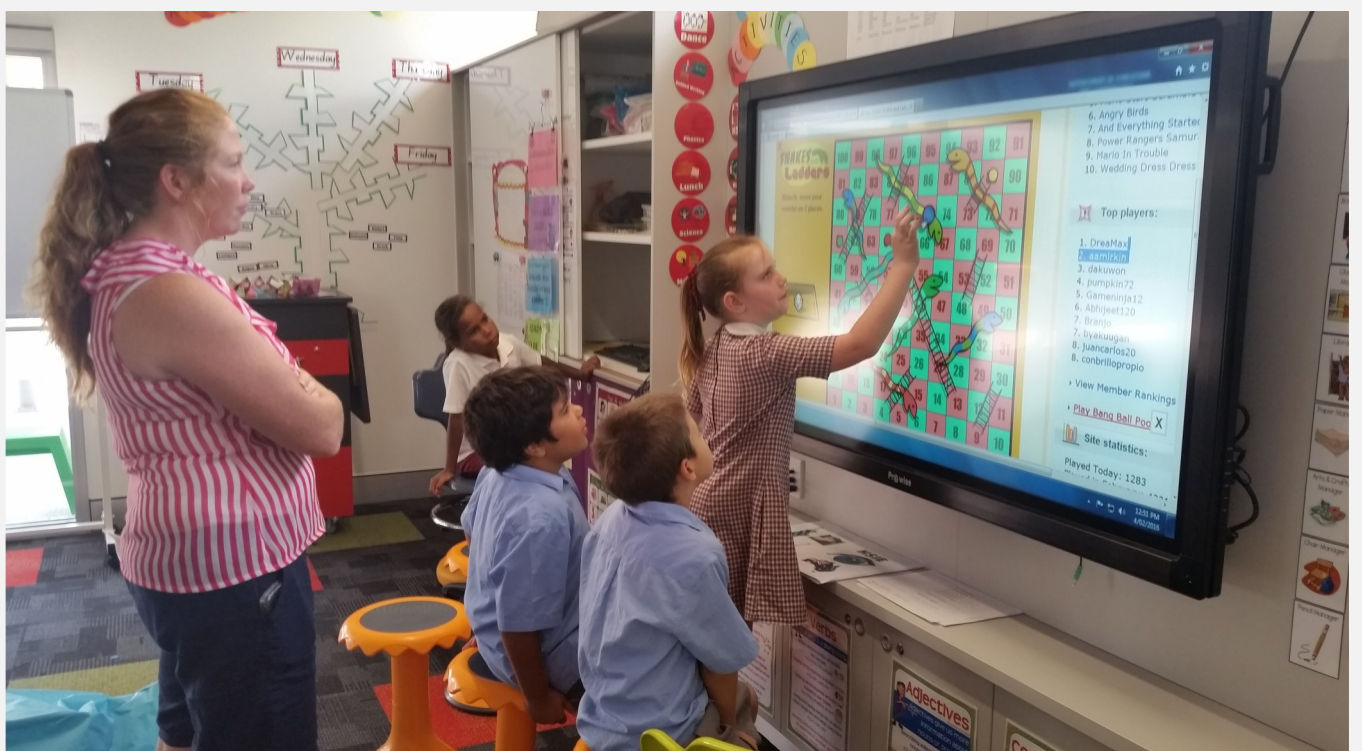

BUS SERVICE

For students who have a bus pass and generally catch a bus to and from school, a bus service will still be operational.

The bus drop off and pick point at the school will still be at the Balo Street gate.

At the end of the school day, students not accessing the Homework Centre are to go directly to the usual bus awaiting area at Balo Street gate.

HOME WORK CENTRE

A Homework Centre, 1:15pm – 3:00pm, Monday to Friday, is available to students **who's parents work or study**. However, to apply for placement in the Homework Centre an application must be submitted for consideration. An application form can be obtained from the front office.

The Homework Centre is a school based activity therefore school policy will apply that is school rules apply to students attending.

The students attending Homework Centre will need to proceed to the cemented area between the hall and canteen (the Breakfast Club area) immediately when the bell rings at 1.15pm where they will meet the Homework Centre coordinator.

After the Homework Centre concludes at 3pm parents are responsible for the collection of their child. However, for those students who generally catch the bus will do so at the Ballo Street gate.

STREET SWEEP

A street sweep bus service will be continue to operate which targets our walkers. **Designated pick up points and times are inclusive of this newsletter**. However, prior to your child accessing this service a permission note will need to be completed and signed. Please contact the school should you wish to access this service

Please note that this is a forward journey to school service only and is not for students who have access to the Reynolds and Fogarty bus service.

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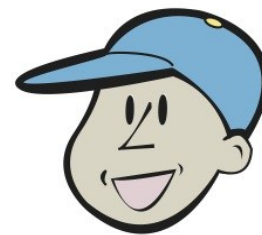
