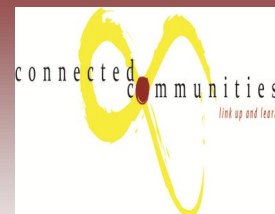

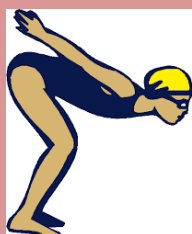

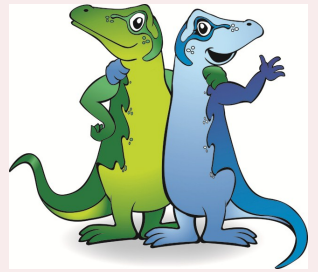

Our PBL focus this week is “What is PBL at MEPS?”

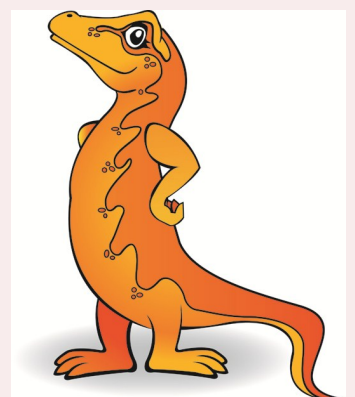
A few things you should know:
