On Monday 25th April, 2016 a small group of students and staff participated in the annual Moree ANZAC commemorations and parade.

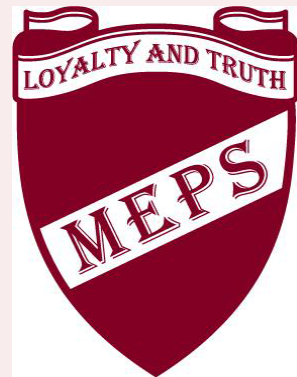
The students that participated were: Donny Rose, Kieya-Madison Carter, Emma Weatherall, Shelby Briggs, Ben & Tiffany Brown.

Summary

Installation of the ceiling sheeting commenced in the hall this month (Block Q) and the amenities rough-in is nearing completion, following a small change to the design following feedback from the school. The roof sheeting has been installed and the tiling is about to commence in the bathrooms. Installation of the structural steel is nearing completion in the new administration building (Block G) and all internal framing has commenced, with the veranda framing currently in progress. The installation of the structural steel will commence this month for the new kindergarten classrooms (Block O) and the framing is complete in the Block E classrooms.

The program for the project has been revised to mitigate the effects of rain delays and ensure the overall project completion is achieved in October 2016. Block G (the new administration building), Block H (the Careunga building) and Block Q (the new hall) will be handed over to the school in July 2016 as Stage 2a, with blocks O (kindergarten classrooms) and E (classrooms) scheduled for handover in mid-August 2016. This staging has been discussed with the stakeholders and is considered the best outcome as it allows the overall completion date to be maintained.

Key tasks completed during the last month for stages 1 and 2

- Installation of Block Q glazing and linings.
- Installation of ceiling grids
- Block G structural steel
- Structure amendments to Block E.

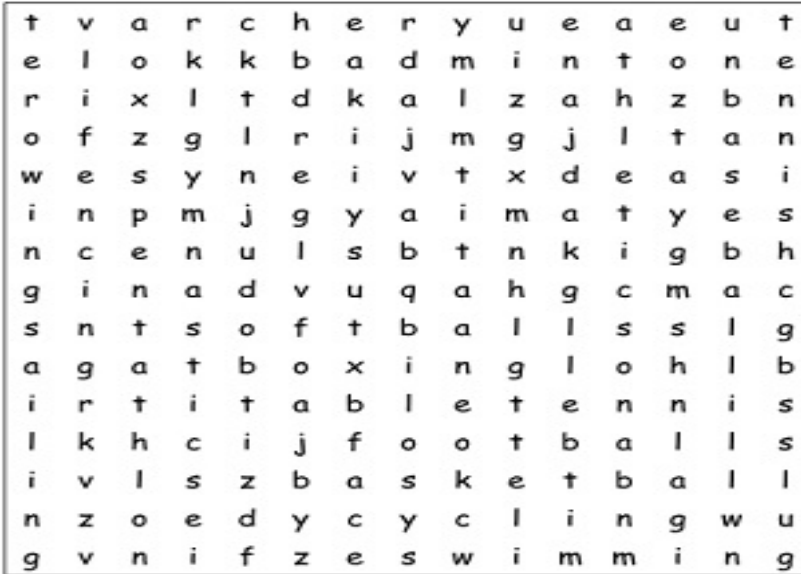
Key tasks to be undertaken in April 2016

- Commence:
 - Structural steel for Block O.
 - Preparation for works in Block H.
 - Tiling and finishes in Block Q bathrooms.
- Provision of sheeting to Block Q and E.



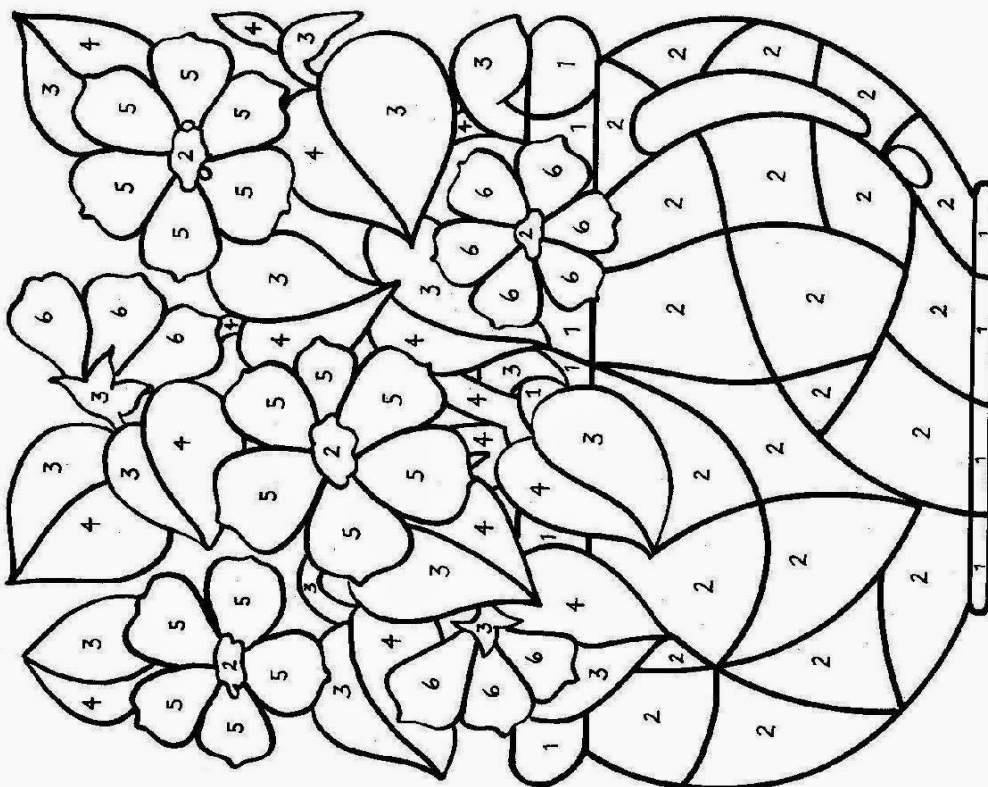
