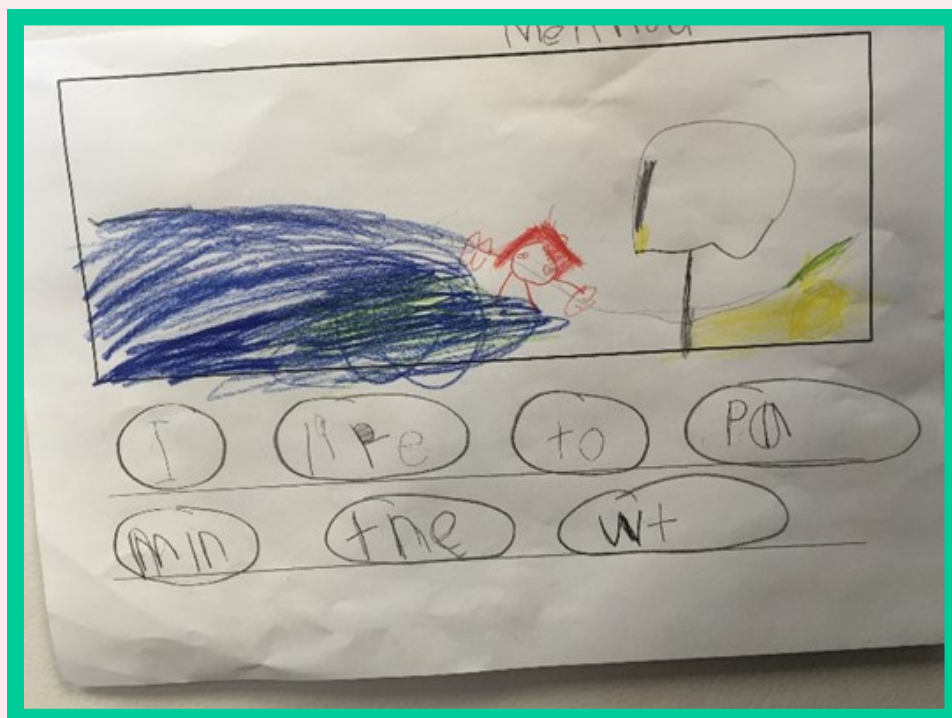


# Learning in KA

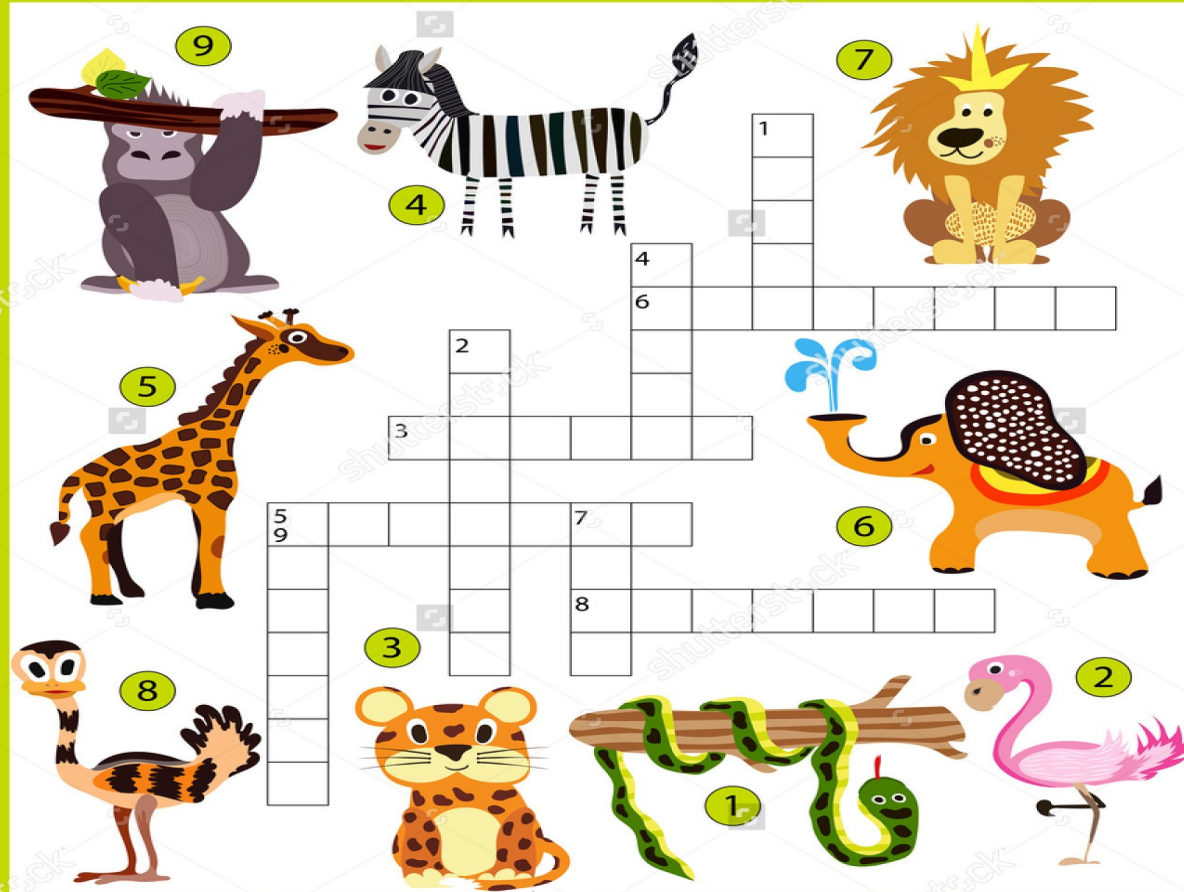
