2017 Kindergarten enrolments

Enrolments are now being accepted for Kindergarten 2017. If you have a child or know of child who is eligible to commence school in 2017 then please make yourself known to the school. To be eligible for Kindergarten in 2017, the child must have turned 5 years of age before the 31st July, 2017.


Tell Them From Me


