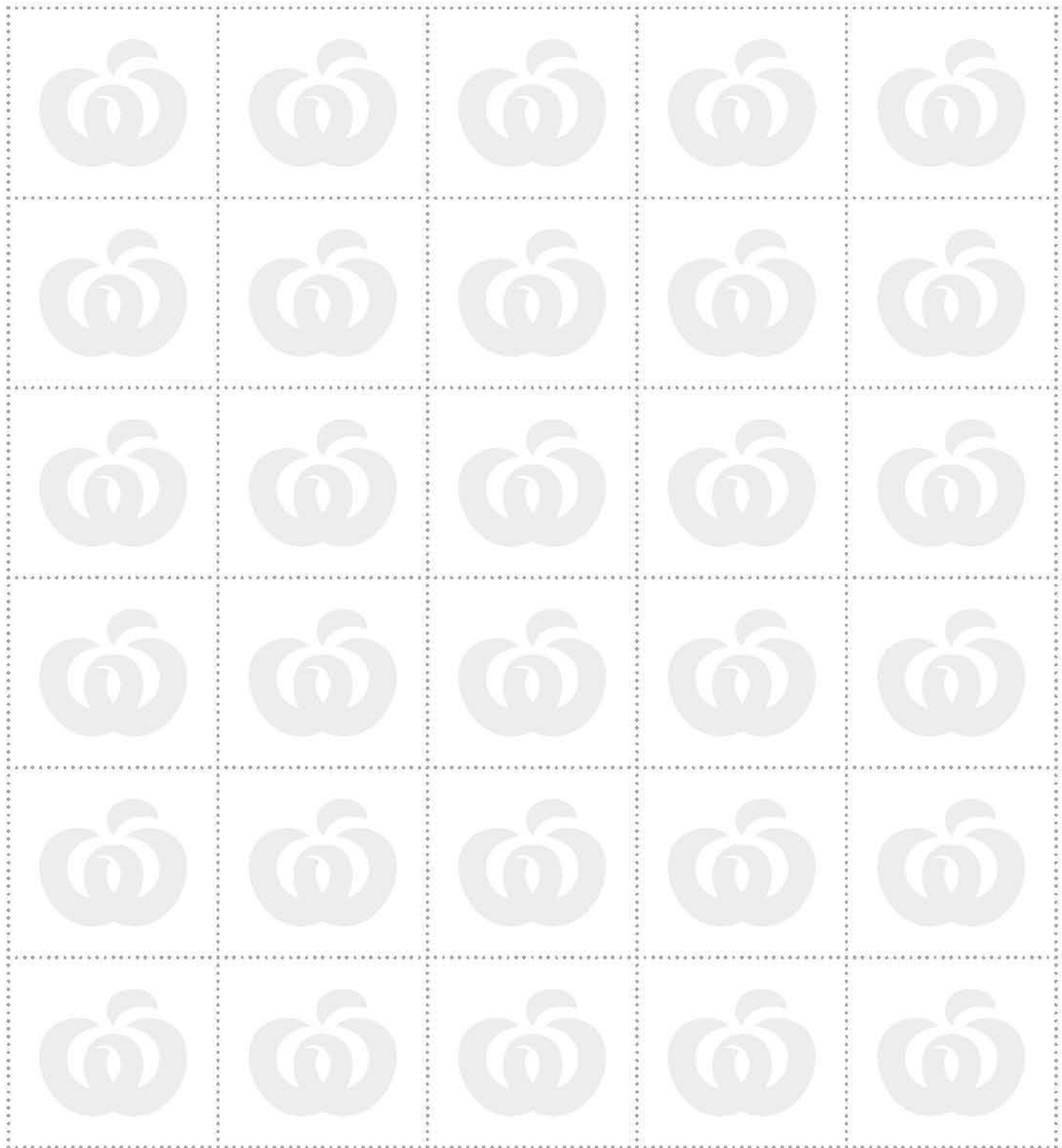
- 1 Inform and encourage your school community**

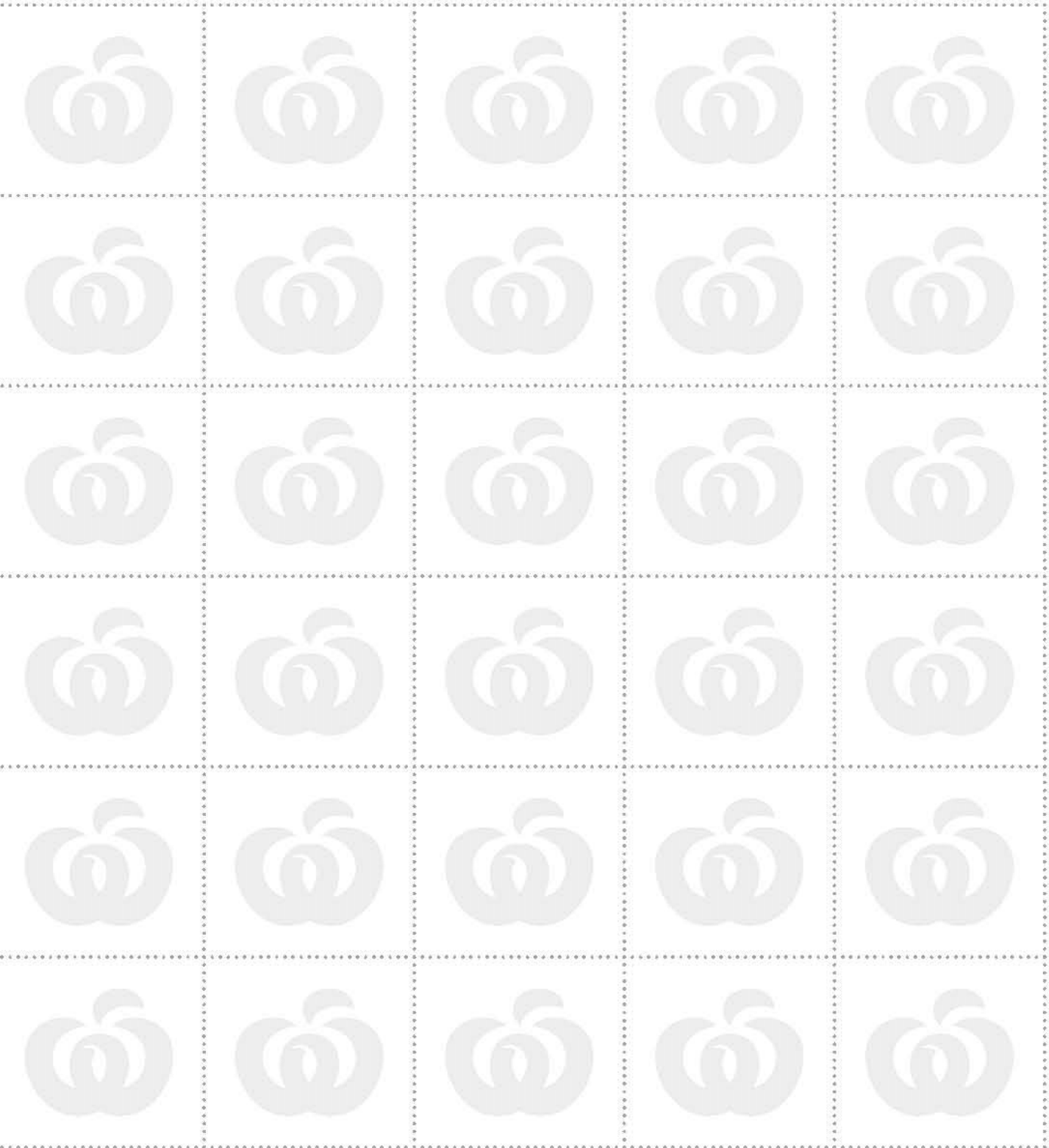
