By next year, only the new uniform will be acceptable at Moree East Public School. This includes the wearing of the school hat and expectation of fully enclosed shoes so that students can access lessons in our community kitchen. This transition phase is designed to support our families with the changeover expectations to the new uniform, by 2019.

After school activities Term 2

We provide activities after school every day until 3pm. We also have the PCYC who provide a service to our students Monday to Friday. Applications for after school care during Term 2 will be made available to families Week 1 next term.

The school programs will require an application form to be completed. The PCYC after school program will also require a new application form and the program will not begin until Week 2 or 3, once all applications have been organised. Thank you to Uncle Matty, Mr Ford and Mrs Cork for supporting our after school programs this term.

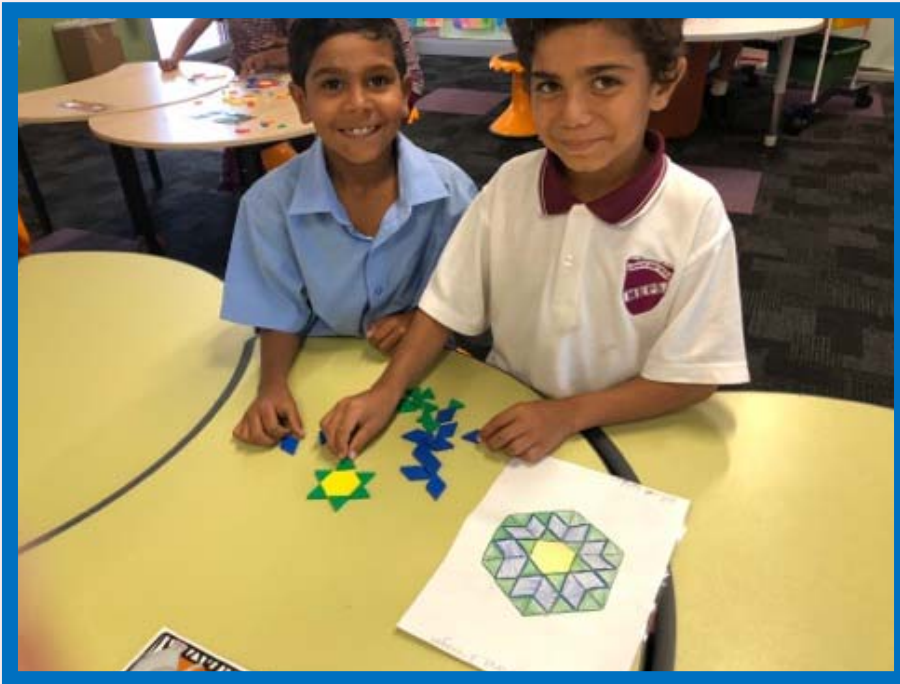

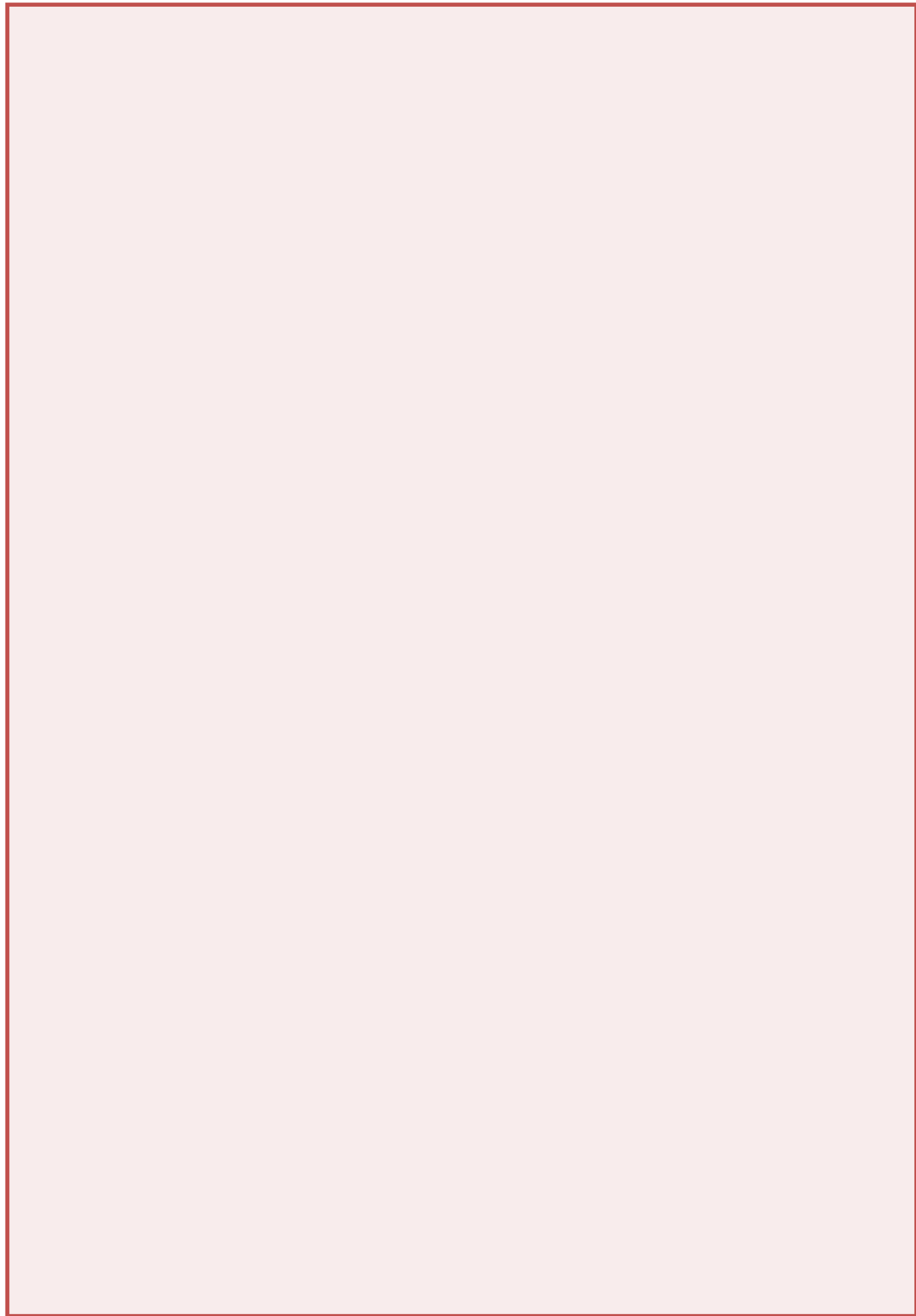
